St. Helena winery Wheeler Farms has several excellent food options, all offered daily by appointment and curated by Chef Sarah Heller, an alum of Meadowood and Bouchon Bistro. Choose between the farm-to-table experience (\$125), which includes four wines paired with savory canapés; either a one-course (\$175) or three-course (\$250) garden lunch; or a tasting, cooking demonstration, and three-course lunch (\$325). No matter what, you'll also get to tour Wheeler Farms' stunning gardens and winery.
